### **The Land Beast of Revelation 13**

Many Christians believe that the Muslims are going to play an important role in the end time scenario. However, Revelation teaches that the beasts will be the most significant players. Thirty-three times "beast" is found in Revelation and about half concern "the beast" but almost the other half have to do with "the image of the beast". The strongest one is in 13:15 where the image to the beast kills you if you don't worship him. The biggest issue in Revelation is NOT the beast nor Muslims but rather the image to the beast.

As America recognizes the anniversary of 9/11 today let us open our Bibles and understand some of these end time events and find comfort in the arms of Jesus.
